NEWSPAPER,
CHIPBOARD - CARDBOARD &
MAGAZINES

Chipboard-cardboard, newspaper,
advertising supplements and magazines.
Can be tied with string or in bags.

MIXED PAPER-

Examples, junk-mail, envelopes, school papers and
computer paper. Mixed paper can be tied with string or
in bags with newspaper, chipboard-cardboard and
magazines. Or by itself.

PLASTIC-

#1 - #7 plastic containers. Remove lids and rinse.

GLASS-

Clear glass bottles and jars only, rinsed clean. (labels can
be left on) NO pyrex, window glass, mirrors or dishes.

CANS-

Aluminum and tin food cans, need to be cleaned and
labels removed.

CORRUGATED-CARDBOARD-

Cardboard broken down.

Item's commonly found in recycling bin's that are not recyclable:

Plastic lids- some container lids have a recyclable #2
emblem on them, these lids are not recyclable due to
nylon content in lid.

Plastic bags from grocery store- are not recyclable
through Johnson County Refuse, but they are
recyclable at certain grocery stores.

Styrofoam products - are not recyclable

Tinted or colored glass- is not recyclable at this time
through Johnson County Refuse. 95% of colored
glass can be returned for deposit.
